Points to be noted from the AGM/Conference

- The Unified Board model was voted on with a clear majority.
- PCV President outlined that the State Council will now open the draft constitution for comment and State Council will develop based on feedback received. Once developed the draft will be reviewed by legal advisors for compliance. It is planned to hold an SGM for clubs to consider approving the new constitution around February 2020.
- Congratulations to Linda Smith who was appointed Vice President. There were also 3 new SC members from Barwon Zone, South Metro Zone and Central Zone.
- Membership – Could all clubs please ensure that they add their Club's Supporting members into the My Club portal.
